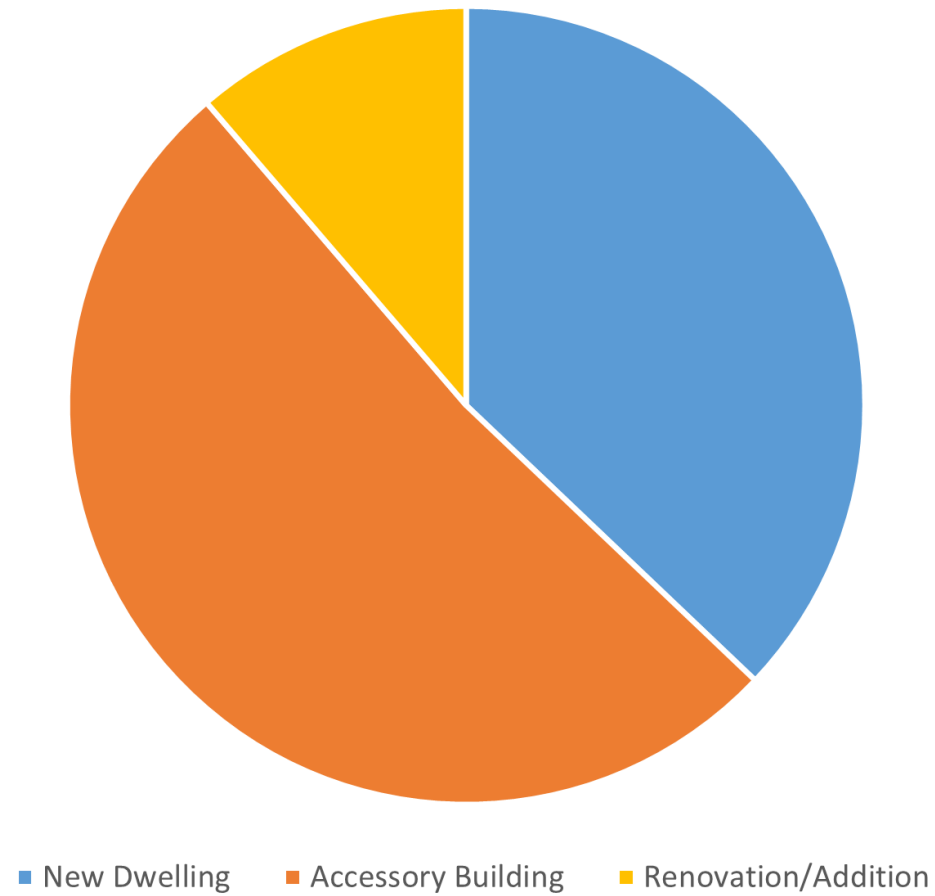
Development 2024

- Total of 121 development permits issued (60 of those being discretionary use) and 66 building permits
- Total of \$7,467,950 in construction value:
 - Q1 – \$1,122,000
 - Q2 – \$4,104,950
 - Q3 – \$1,926,000
 - Q4 – \$315,000

Development 2024

- 23 new dwellings across the RM
- Division 4 had the most development with 47 building permits
- Lakeshore development accounted for 75% of total building permits
- 14 subdivision applications received

RM of Mervin No. 499 Residential Building Permits - 2024

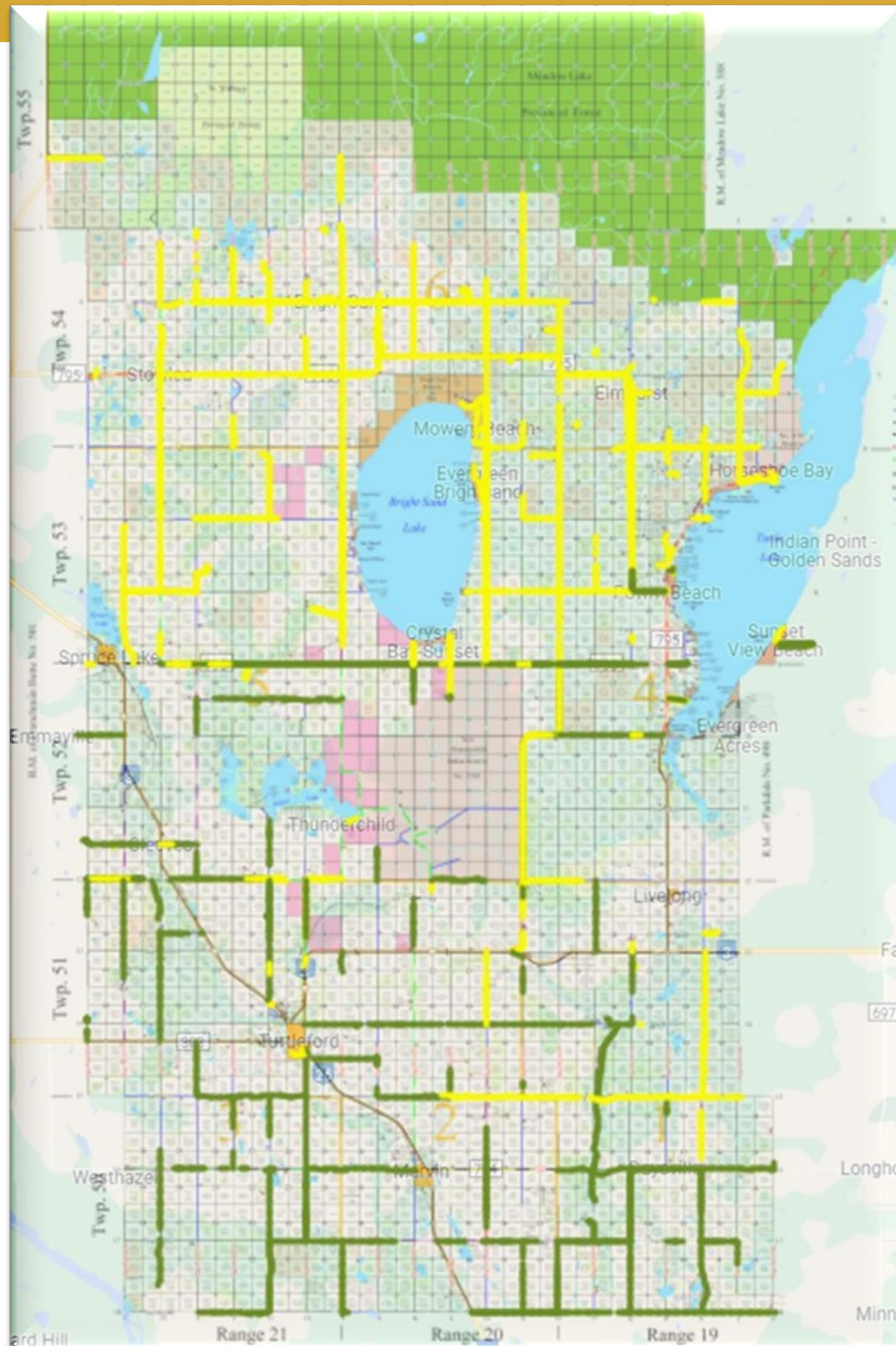

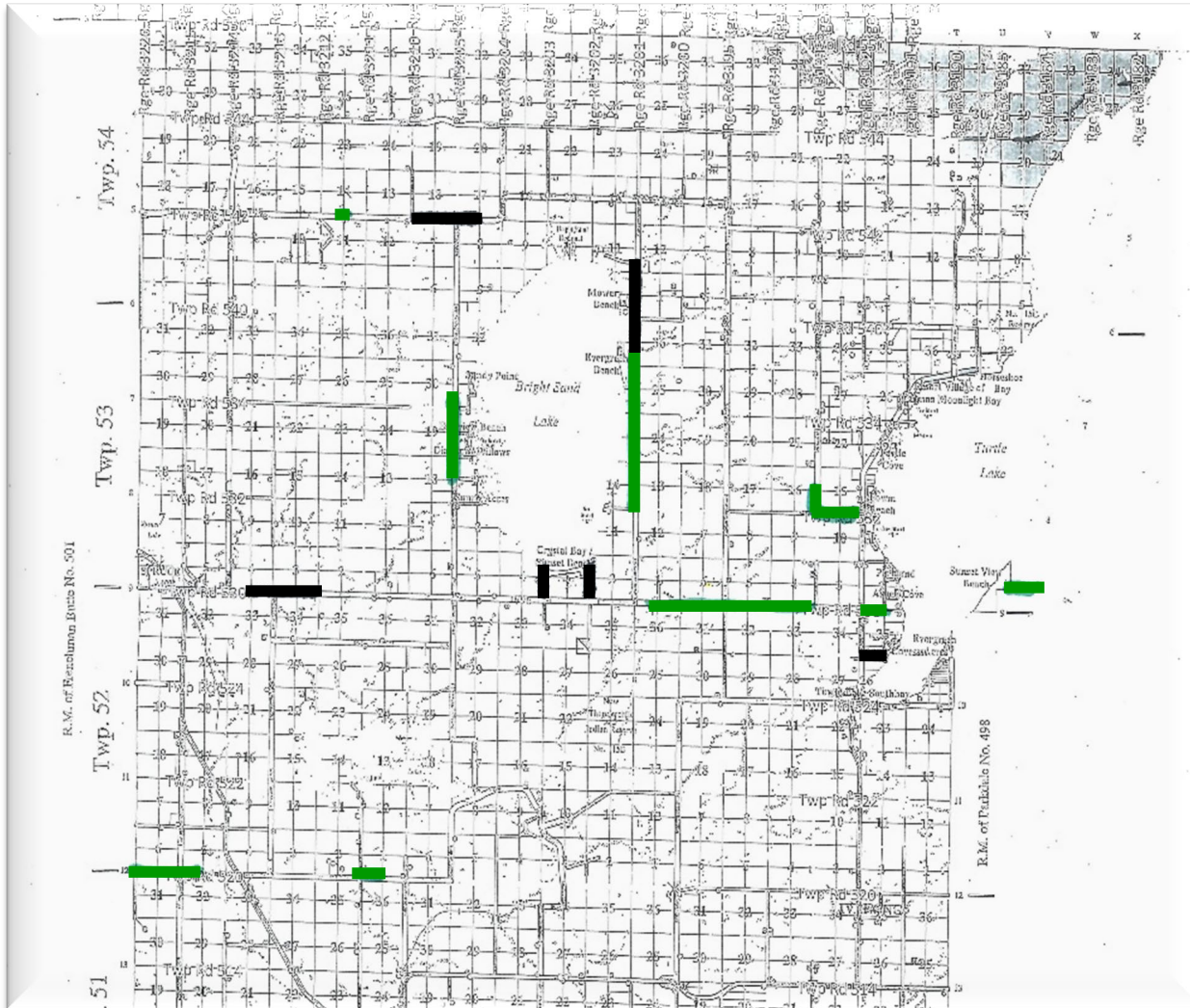

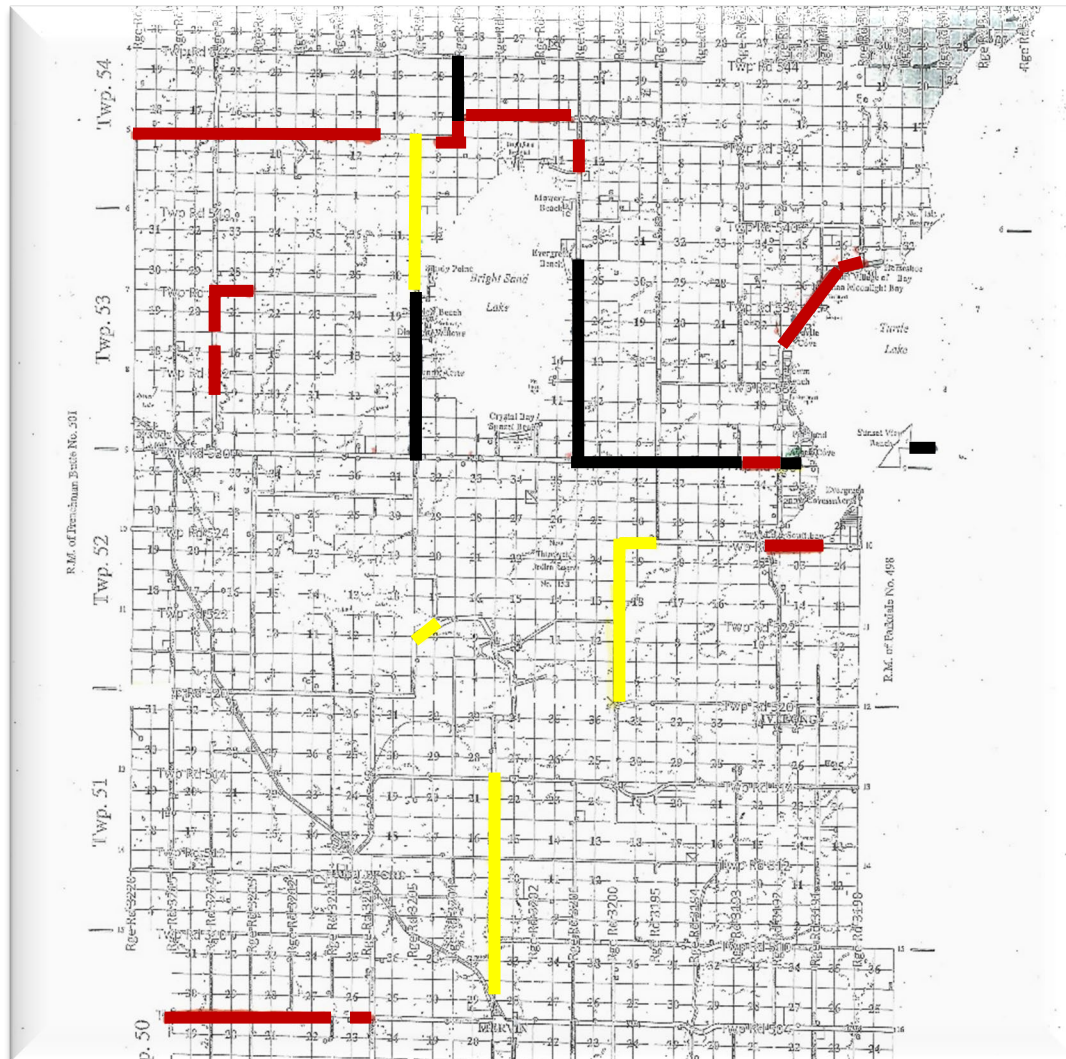

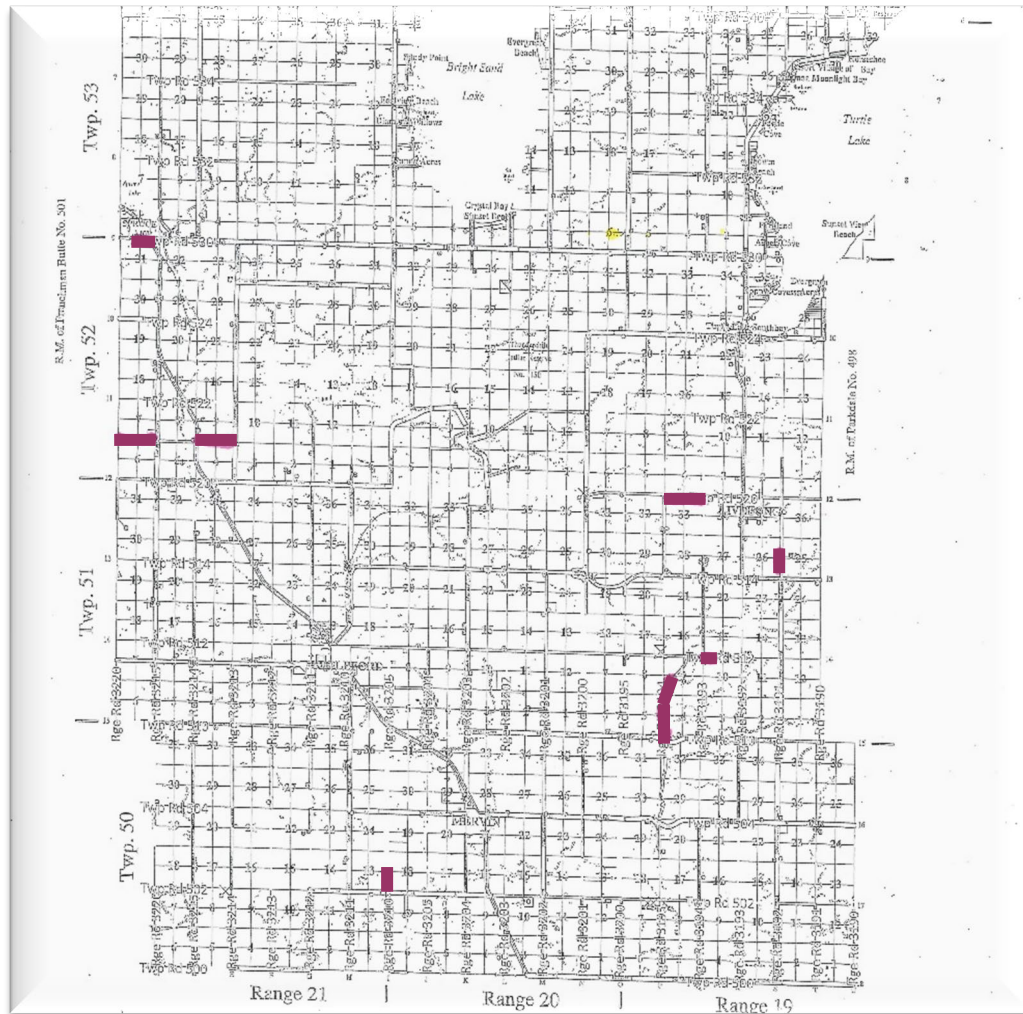

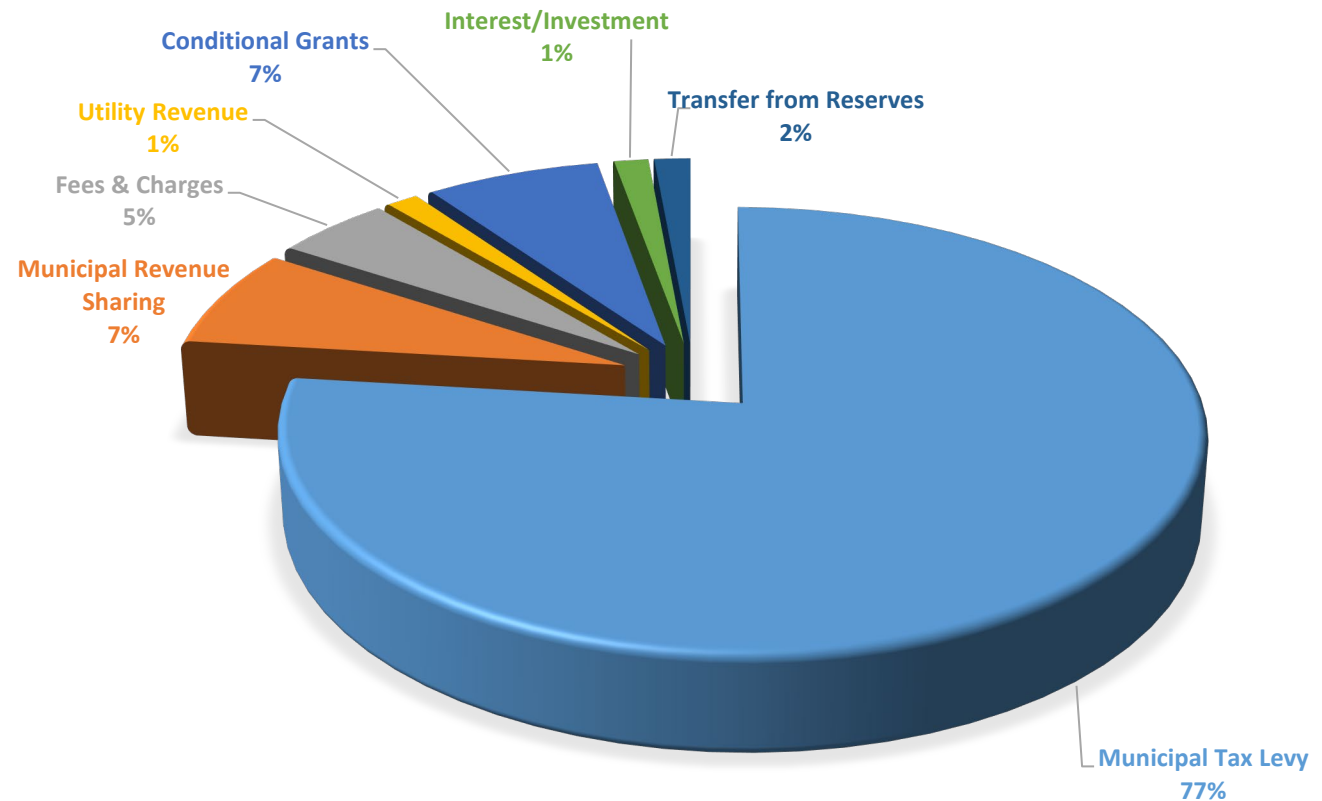
Tree Mulching 2025

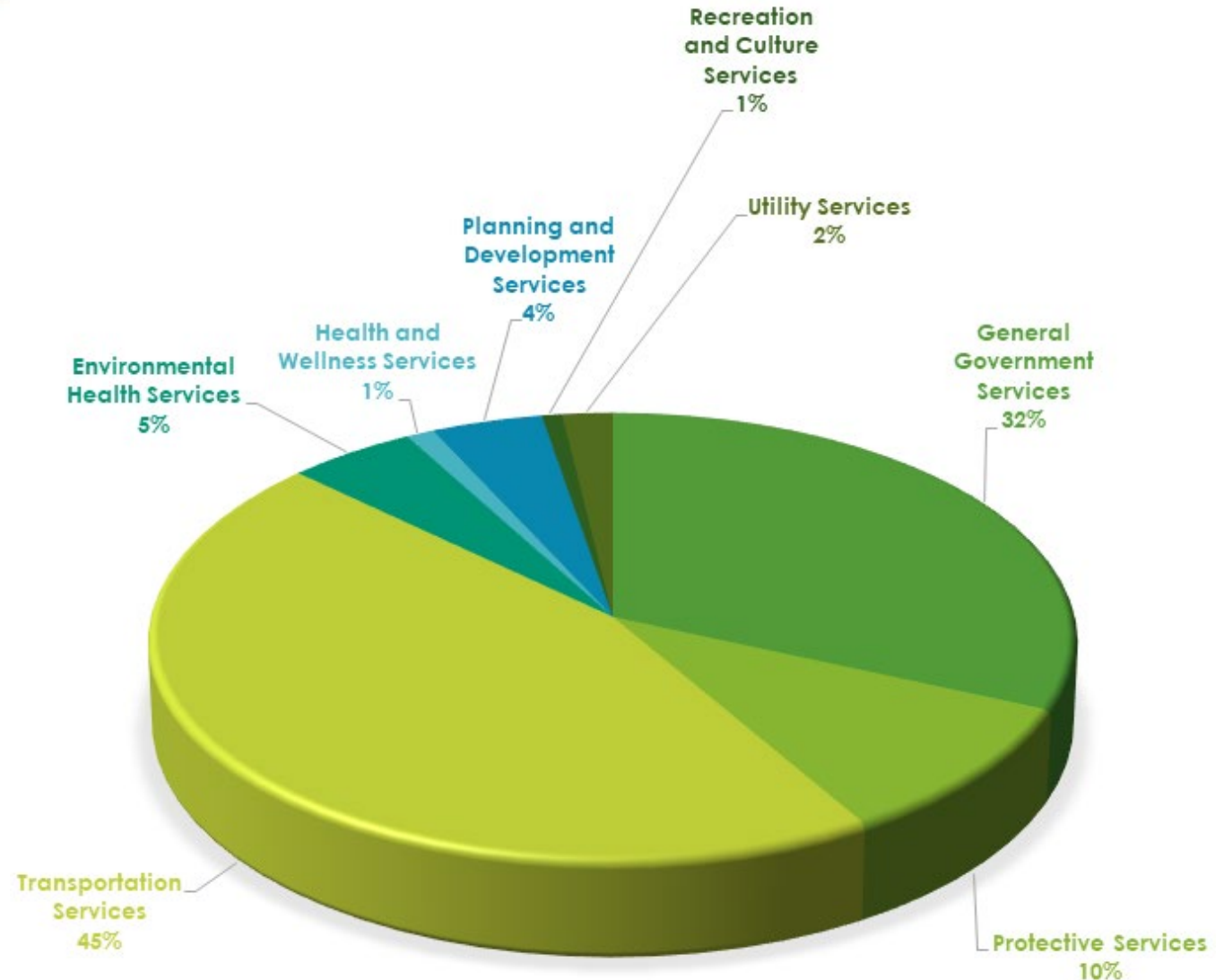
