BYLAW # 2011-09

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE ORGANIZED HAMLET OF LIVELONG IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MERVIN NO. 499.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Mervin No. 499, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:

- (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Public Highway Act, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act:
- (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Act.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 30 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public highway within the Organized Hamlet of Livelong.
- 3. Section 2 shall not apply to the operators of fire engines and fire department apparatus and operators of an ambulance where these vehicles are being operated on emergency duty and employing the siren and flashing red lights.
- 4. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone.

5. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
