

BYLAW #98-3

**A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES
PURSUANT TO SECTION 206(2) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Mervin No. 499, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act:
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than 50 kilometers per hour on that portion of a public highway described as follows: West of the South West of Quarter Section 7, Township 51, Range 20, West of the Third Meridian and W of the North West of Quarter Section 6, Township 51, Range 20, West of the Third Meridian described as the most Northerly 200 feet.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.


