

BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY
Section 12 HPA, R.S.S. 1978, c.H-2.2, as amended

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Mervin #499 to designate a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has determined that the lands and premises known as:

THE BROOKSDALE SCHOOL SITE

and located at:

1 & 1/2 miles North of the Village of Mervin then turn East and continue 5 miles where you will come upon The Brooksdale School Site on the North side of the road.

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, paleontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, caused a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

- a. served on the owners of said property;
- b. served on the Registrar of Heritage Property;
- c. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property in the appropriate Land Titles Office; and,
- d. published in one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

All that portion of the South East quarter of Section (5),
in Township Fifty-one (51),
in Range Nineteen (19),
West of the Third Meridian,
in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada,
described as follows:

COMMENCING at the South West corner of the said quarter section; thence Northerly along the Westerly limit of said quarter section Two Hundred and Ninety-five and Sixteen Hundreths (295.16) feet; thence Easterly parallel with the South boundary of the said quarter section Two Hundred and Ninety-five and Sixteen Hundreths (295.16) feet; thence Southerly and parallel with the Western boundary of the said quarter section Two Hundred and Ninety-five and Sixteen Hundreths (295.16) feet; to the South boundary of the said quarter section; thence Westerly along the Southern boundary of the said quarter section to the place of commencement, containing Two (2) acres, more or less.

EXCEPTING: Ten Hundreths (0.10) of an acre, more or less, taken for Roadway as shown on Plan of Record in Land Titles Office for the Battleford Land Registration District as No. 76-B-10166.

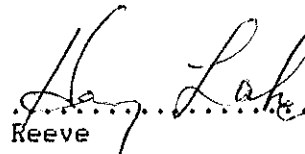
The significance of the site being:

- a. Brooksdale School served the educational needs of the district for 40 school years and it represents one of the very few remaining examples of a typical country school in this area.
 - b. Brooksdale School stands in excellent restored condition on the original land site in which it was built in 1919.
 - c. Brooksdale School has been a historic landmark for 75 years and should be designated for the interest and benefit of people to follow.
2. The Municipal Administrator/Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a Notice of Designation to be:
- a. registered on the Certificate of Title for said property at the appropriate Land Titles Office; and,
 - b. served on the owners of said property.
3. The Municipal Administrator/Clerk is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw, with a copy of the Notice of Designation, to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.

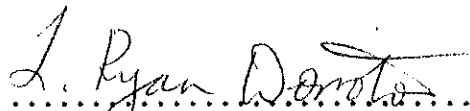

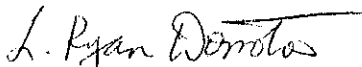
