Greetings fellow Evergreen Beach property owners. Another year at the lake is starting. Below are a few things we, your Hamlet Board, think may interest you.

### **Annual General Meeting (AGM)**

# **Boat and Personal Watercraft (PWC) Speed Limits**

Transport Canada regulation limits watercraft speeds to 10Km/h within 30m (100ft.) of shore. Please do your part and make sure you are well away from the shoreline when using boats and PWCs. It's a BIG Lake. Go out to the middle. It is less disturbing to your neighbors and it reduces shoreline erosion.

#### **Access to Beach**

Last year the RM installed fencing in the easement leading to the lake between Brightsand Place and Treylane Place to restrict the size of vehicles that can access the beach. Someone who thinks they are above the law chose to remove this fence and damaged it in the process. That's your tax dollars you're wasting!

**THERE IS NO BOAT LAUNCH** in the Hamlet. If you want to launch a boat or PWC you can do so at the Reginal park for a nominal fee.

### **Hamlet Speed Limit**

Once again, our ongoing reminder that the speed limit in the Hamlet is 20 Km/h. This is for all vehicles including ATVs, on all roads and beach accesses. Please **SLOW DOWN** and watch for pedestrians. Remember, ATV joy riding is not allowed on the beach, roads, or in the ditches in the Hamlet.

# Dog Bylaw

A reminder to all residents and guests that the RM has a bylaw requiring all dogs to be controlled by their owners at all times. A copy of the bylaw is available on the Hamlet website.

# **Open Fires**

Please be careful with all open fires within the Hamlet and make sure they are in a proper fire pit. There is a guideline for building your fire pits located on the Hamlet website. Remember that no open fires are allowed during a fire ban. Fire bans are posted on the RM website and the Hamlet board will post a sign at the front entrance when a fire ban is in effect.
