- 1. Called to order at 10:02 by Hamlet chairman Ryan Hinz
  - a. In attendance: Board members Ryan Hinz, Bob Day, Ralph Renwick (recorder) and RM Councilor Rob Blais and 65 property owners.
- 2. Agenda presented and amended to include:
  - a. Golf carts

  - d. Green space sub-committee

  - f. Community Garage Sale

Motion to approve agenda by Larry Sauer; seconded by Lyle Baxter. Carried.

- 3. 2023 Hamlet Board Chairman's report of activities presented by Ryan Hinz
- 4. May 21, 2023 AGM Minutes read by Ryan Hinz. Minutes adopted as read by Kelly Hamilton; seconded by Michael Dallman. Carried.
- 5. Business arising from minutes:
  - a. Fire exit complete except for gates.
  - b. Green space leveled, seeded, and grass growing.

Acknowledged by Larry Sauer as presented; seconded by Michael Dallman; carried.

- 6. The board has requested a list of permanent residents per house and anyone needing assistance in case of an emergency such as a fire. The board also requests contact numbers so owners could be notified for circumstances such as fallen tree(s) or fires, etc.
- 7. New Hamlet Board Policy (as per province regulations):
  - a. Voting allowed by titled owners and spouses only.

  - c. Meetings to be posted. (Hamlet web page and Facebook) so public can observe or participate. (board must be notified 7 days prior to the scheduled meeting)
  - d. Conflict of interest is to be stated by board members at start of each meeting.

## 8. Budget and Finances:

a. Ryan Hinz presented the 2023 expense summary and the 2024 budget. Pump-outs and road maintenance were the highest expensed items.

- c. Clarence Taylor report:
  - i. Flowers were stolen from the entrance to Evergreen Hamlet.
  - ii. Three fire pits were without lids.
  - iii. One fire was going during the Fire Ban.

- c. Jim Koontz suggested signs be put up for location of each AED device

#### 13. Other business

- c. Fire pump should be moved close to marina to supply water for emergencies.
- d. Hamlet of Evergreen reserve fund now receives interest.
