Community Enhancement Ideas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Beach Clearing Permit <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A protection permit has been received to enhance the beach to accommodate increased public usage. ○ The beach cannot be expanded in width but not length as we look to be at max there, based on satellite images. Roughly from lot 118 north ○ The sooner actioned on the better as permit is good for only one year (Valid till March 31, 2024) ○ Permit allows for removal of stumps, reeds can be pulled, harrows can be used. ○ Sand can be brought in, but cation is required in terms of what sand, i.e can be dirty or not approved for use. ○ Dwight could be used to clear additional area as permitted. ▪ Public Area <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Public space has become overgrown, Dwight could brush cut it. 		Mike to talk to Dwight on beach and public area clearing.

Brush in centre is of no use and can go. ○ Perimeter creates a block for surrounding lots and encloses any use of the lot.
