Old Business-

Sask Power: Stan Bergen has followed up with Sask Power and cost is ball park figure of 200,000.00 dollars plus everyone needs to have lines buried to each home, along with dealing with telephone and fiber optics. Cost is growing. Along with discussion concerning impact with land owners south of Evergreen Acres. It has been decided to take this next year to AGM for a vote to continue or leave to rest.

Concern on trimming of trees: Les Olsen suggested that we have someone monitor when tree trimming is to occur. So if anyone knows of trimming to occur. Please email Trent Gatzke so he can be there to monitor so we don't have any issues moving forward. Also, a big thankyou to Les for continuously dealing with SASK Power until golf course damage was rectified.

Evergreen Sign: Kyle has sample, residents had chance for input but Kyle will send to Evergreen Acres board once he has final draft on a few and we can perhaps get feedback thru emails.

Buoys: Bea spoke on where we are at. We require more info on each buoy (PRIV, address info) and we will place them back in next summer. No issues with Transport Canada re location or depth they were at, just the marking on them. So we will get additional stickers and fix them up.

Fireplan: The RM along with Turtleford Fire Dept have an extensive document that the Board will deal with. It is a document who to contact, what we have for fire suppression etc. Board will tend to this.

Lagoon Dredge: Brad Trent and Rick Mathews have been in contact with Mitchell Bros. So that has been postponed until Mitchells are available. Mitchells hope to tend to this around Sept 20/26.

Pea Gravel will be added to walkways Mitchells will deliver and spread.

Grading: Hamlet has had Doug Bannerman reclaim the road gravel, (skid steer with a hydra bucket on back of bucket), looks like worked well, rejuvenated the existing gravel on cul de sac roads. We will look if new gravel is required in spring.

New Dock: Joan Thompson brought up that we need to fix or get new platform that leads to boat launch dock. Kyle will look into what we can purchase.

New Business:

Trent spoke on RM request that was made by board to allow a sea can be placed in lagoon area for hamlet storage (aeration fans, rough cut mower, and buoys.) Still awaiting reply from RM. If allowed board will purchase either a 20ft or 40 sea can.

Volunteers : board is looking for volunteers to take on specific tasks (boat launch dock, diving dock, AED) Discussed and we will continue as we are and Trent will contact Rick Mathews and see if he is willing to monitor AED battery and pads.

Round Table:

Tom Stephenson: suggested we get cul de sacs floated, Trent said he will tend to that this weekend.

Corey Riess: Sea can great idea, we need to create plan for what we may be wanting in hamlet.

Brad : Lagoon Report : lots of water going into fall. Pumping is going good and we will be able to have Mitchells dredge. Health of Lagoon is good. Mower is working great, we may need to require to upgrade the pulling (tractor) of equipment. Brad reminded everyone to whipper snip around your stored items. Recommendation to have pest control representative for RM to look at Mole control. Brad also asked that if anyone wants to help with mowing at Lagoon pls contact. The person will have to supply something to pull mower.

Brad also mentioned that a Hour meter should be added to mower so we can log hours for maintenance. Trent will look into it. (Byron Wolf volunteered to help mow at both lagoon and golf course.)
