- 1. Chair Corey opened meeting at 10am
- 2. Introduction of gues t Paige Hundt (RM of Mervin Planner) Introduction of attendees
- 3. Minutes of 2022 AGM were Read Motion to accept: Kevin Heisler
- 4. Old business:

<u>Lagoon Cleaning</u>: Corey spoke re dredging; it may not be needed if we look into chemical cleaning. Corey will contact Aquadeo to see who they used for their sludge assessment. He will have a sludge assessment done to see how to address cell #1 condition.

<u>Storage Area</u>: No movement Corey spoke with RM. Corey said if anyone wishes to move forward with this project contact Corey, to take this on. *Motion to remove from minutes so the Board does not proceed. 2nd by Brad Caplan, All in favor*

<u>Calcium Chloride</u>: Update, Sales oil use is not allowed in the province of Saskatchewan, The Rm and all of its subsidiaries must follow Sask. Legislation and can not have policies that supersed Provincial or Federal legislations. Calcium Chloride, discussion took place and decision to continue with Calcium Chloride. Ferlin brought forward Magnesium Chloride idea, but with this comes more cost incurred with needing a water truck and work done on road so Magnesium permeates the top. So plan is to stick with Cal/Chloride at present but perhaps only apply every 2/3 years apart. Also, strict instructions were provided to the RM on when, where and how the CaCl is to be applied. Les suggested placing speed bump on road, but many opposed to that. *Vote for application: majority in favor.*

<u>Electronic Speed Sign:</u> Corey will be applying for a grant thru SGI in July to assist in paying for one. Kevin Heisler suggested 30 km sign be moved south of lagoon area. Decision on purchasing one once we hear back from SGI grant.

<u>Fire Hose:</u> The RM of Mervin have no liability concerns for the Hamlet if we store Fire hoses at Evergreen for personal use. Paige discussed perhaps we could as in Turtle View (which have a truck and fire brigade) would consider our fire needs. Corey will contact them and see if they would consider that.

<u>Main Road Maintenance</u>: RM will address if there are major concerns, but we require to call the maintenance foreman (Carey) at RM.

Evergreen Clothing: send email if interested to Connie or Corey Riess and they will update you.

Internet: Star Link works amazing, Xplornet works for some also.

<u>Pond Pump</u>: New aeration pump is on order and we can only get from PondPro in Camrose now. Aeration pumps are working great and have helped with Lagoon sustainability.

Les Olsen made a motion that the Hamlet proceed with Disk Golf Course being added to our existing golf course to a maximum contribution of 10,000. Incurred by Hamlet.

We will also look into donation from residents and offering tax free receipts.

Brad also spoke re Lagoon health: Cell 1 is down 3 feet and Aeration is working, and Lagoon testing is coming back good.
