BYLAW #2000-10

A BYLAW TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ANIMALS.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Mervin No. 499, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Mervin No. 499;
 - (b) "being at large" and "be at large" shall mean when the dog is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner or harbourer of the said dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner of the said land, and when it is not under control by being:
 - (i) in the direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or
 - (ii) securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - (iii) securely leashed so that it cannot roam at will.
- 2. This bylaw shall apply to all organized and un-organized Hamlets within the Rural Municipality of Mervin No. 499.
- 3. A dog shall not be allowed to be at large in the Municipality.
- 4. A person who owns or harbours a dog found being at large is guilty of a fine not exceeding \$50.00.
- 5. (a) A violator of this bylaw, upon being served with a Notice of Violation, may, during office hours, voluntarily pay the penalty at the office of the Municipality and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not be liable to prosecution for the offence.
 - (b) The Notice of Violation shall be in Form "?", attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 6. This bylaw comes into effect the date of passing.
