

## **THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF MERVIN #499**

### **EXPENSES INCURRED ON BEHALF OF RATEPAYERS**

- an office for administration as well as the office equipment and stationary supplies
- salaries for administrative staff
- general insurance and liability insurance
- remuneration for elected officials
- costs associated with the development and maintenance of an Official Community Plan and Zoning bylaw, which is updated from time to time. This includes costs for professional planning services for subdivision proposals as well as development permit reviews
- legal fees, tax enforcement costs and fees for annual audits conducted by a chartered accountant
- election costs and memberships to affiliated associations like the Saskatchewan Association of Rural Municipalities and the Provincial Association of Resort Communities of Saskatchewan
- the cost to have the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) provide and update property Assessment values for each piece of property in the Municipality
- public library levy as well as costs associated in the operation and maintenance of the building
- North Sask. River Municipal Health Levy to Administer and Operate Clinic facilities including recruitment and retention of Physicians
- costs associated with the capital and maintenance of jointly owned housing facilities for Physicians
- Fire protection services including the capital cost for fire protection equipment and operational costs of maintaining a fire hall and providing reimbursement to volunteer fire fighters
- Sask. Justice requisition for R.C.M.P. policing costs
- EMO Co-coordinator
- costs associated with administering and providing a rat control program for the Municipality
- the cost to engineer and construct roads within the Municipality
- capital costs for equipment required for road maintenance and snow plowing
- maintenance costs and equipment repairs
- wages for heavy equipment operators and maintenance personnel
- the cost to gravel municipal roads including crushing, applicable royalties and trucking
- the cost to purchase culverts for drainage as well as the cost to replace municipal signs
- the cost to provide the municipalities waste disposal site for property owners
- the cost to provide a municipal lagoon for septic haulers to dispose of sewage removed from septic tanks
